

Camporee Packing List

- 2 Night Sleepout in Tents.
- Include Clothes for Specified Theme.
- Scouts cook all their meals.
- Pack into duffel bag or 2900 cubic inch backpack.
- Check weather forecast for weekend.
- Pack appropriate Clothing.
- NO SANDALS

Personal Gear:

Class A Uniform – Including shirt, neckerchief, and slide
Clothes for the Camporee's Theme (i.e., hillbilly, cowboy, survivor, etc.)
(3) Class B T-shirts (1 worn in travel, 2 in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Class B Pants or Shorts (Depending on the weather)
Underwear (1 pair worn in travel, 2 pair in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Sweat Pants (Pajamas)
Sweat Shirt or Polar Fleece Jacket
Stocking Cap (Can be worn in sleep to keep in body heat) (Depending on the weather)
Coat (Depending on Weather)
Wool Hiking Socks (1 pair worn in travel, 2 pair in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Sock Liners (1 pair worn in travel, 2 pair in the pack) (Change into at bedtime)
Hiking Boots
Sleeping Pad
Sleeping Bag or Fleece Bag Liner (Depending on the weather)
Stuff Sack for Sleeping Bag (Use as pillow by stuffing with clothes at night)
Rain Suit (Pants and Jacket)
Scout Handbook
2 Nalgene Bottles (1 – Water ONLY, 1 – Smellable Juice)
Personal First Aid Kit
Personal Grooming Kit (Includes mirror, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, soap, washcloth)
Hand Sanitizer (Travel Size)
Flashlight
Insulated Mug with Lid
Boonie Hat
Pocket Knife
Multi-Purpose Tool
Compass
Emergency Whistle
Strike Anywhere Matches (In Waterproof Container)
Pencil/Pen
Note Pad
Deck of Playing Cards/Dice
Leather Work Gloves (For fire duty)
Camp Chair
Toilet Paper
Handkerchief/Tissues
Sewing Kit (Buttons, thread, needle and thimble)

Optional Equipment:

Food for Patrol (For cooking duty)
Menu/Duty Roster (If assigned to create)
Cooler for Patrol food
Camera Gear (Disposable Camera)
Personal Journal
Book to read
